

IDX FLINT - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (ROUND 4)

IDX FLINT is a program that sparks the interest, ideas and talent of young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in making digital technology. IDX Flint provides \$15,000 (AUD) of in-kind support from the IDX Initiative for regional communities through three days of hands on workshops for young people, one day of skills development for local facilitators; a community BBQ; and a tailored kit of equipment and educational resources to the value of \$10,000 (AUD).

All IDX Flint activities will take place between September 2017 - March 2018.

Closing Dates

This call for Expressions of Interest (EOI) from interested participants opens on **Monday 1 May 2017** and closes midnight **Thursday 15 June 2017**.

Notification as to outcomes will occur in July 2017 and invitations to consider the specific terms and conditions of participation will be issued at this time to selected potential participants for consideration.

Who can submit an EOI?

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations based outside of Sydney and in regional locations. This round of FLINT will target **WA, SA, ACT and TAS**.

Other organisations which operate programs for the benefit of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, based outside of Sydney and in regional locations will be considered.

Selection Criteria

- Strength of partnerships and relationships in the community and surrounding areas
- Interest from the community to learn and explore digital technology
- Potential to include digital technology workshops and resources into community initiatives, post FLINT engagement
- Current activities that are run for children and young people (8 - 18 yo)
- Minimum of 6 facilitators, which must include community/staff members, elders and young people
- Training in all learning experiences that IDX deliver when in community in 2017
- Identify an available space to run workshops, show work and keep equipment safe and secure in community
- Based in WA, SA, ACT and TAS

An Indigenous peer panel will assess the EOIs including their effectiveness in:

- Increasing participation of Indigenous people in arts and culture, land management and community wellbeing; and
- Enhancing the potential for social enterprise, entrepreneurship and/or career development within the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.
